You are responsible for ensuring that all persons who access our site through your internet connection are aware of, and comply with these terms of use and other applicable terms and conditions.

We amend these terms from time to time. Every time you wish to use our site, please check these terms to ensure you understand the terms that apply at that time. These terms were most recently updated on 01/10/2023.

Our site is made available free of charge. We do not guarantee that it, or any content on it, will always be available or be uninterrupted. We may update and change our site from time to time to reflect changes to our products, our users' needs and our business priorities, and we may suspend or withdraw or restrict the availability of all or any part of it at any time for business or operational reasons.

Please note that these terms do not apply to any contract for the purchase of the vehicle itself, nor to any contract for the provision of financial credit.

They apply to the exclusion of any other terms that you seek to impose or incorporate, or which are implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing.

If you do not agree to these terms, you must not use our site.

These terms apply to any contract which may be concluded between us for the reservation and/or test drive of a vehicle you have found on this site. They are intended to represent the entire agreement between you and us in relation to its subject matter. If you are a business customer these terms constitute the entire agreement between us in relation to your purchase, and you acknowledge that you have not relied on any statement, promise, representation, assurance or warranty made or given by or on behalf of us which is not set out in these terms. If you are a consumer and believe you have relied on any statement, promise or representation or assurance or warranty that is not set out in these terms, please contact us to clarify the position.

We reserve the right to amend the specification of any vehicle described on this site if required to do so by any applicable statutory or regulatory requirement, to implement minor technical adjustments and improvements, or if the amendment will not materially affect its nature or quality.

Our site is only for users in the UK

Our site is directed to people residing in the United Kingdom. We do not represent that content available on or through our site is appropriate for use or available in other locations. You may use this site to reserve a vehicle or test drive from an address outside the United Kingdom, but we do not deliver vehicles outside the United Kingdom, and any test drives must take place at the address in the United Kingdom which we specify. Finance quotes are not applicable to persons residing outside the United Kingdom.

Reserving a vehicle or booking a test drive

Please follow the onscreen prompts to reserve your vehicle or book a test drive.

You must co-operate with us in all matters relating to the booking, and provide us with such information as we may reasonably require in order to fulfil the booking, and ensure that such information is complete and accurate in all material respects, and you hold a full UK driving licence on the date booked for the test drive.

After you submit the booking, you will receive an email from us acknowledging that we have received it, but please note that this does not mean that it has been accepted. Our acceptance will take place when we send an email to you.

If we are unable to reserve the vehicle or offer you a test drive on the specified date, we will inform you of this by email. This might be because the vehicle has already been sold, because of unexpected limits on our resources which we could not reasonably plan for, because a credit reference we have obtained for you does not meet our minimum requirements, because we have identified an error in the price or description of the vehicle or because we are unable to meet an agreed deadline.

We will use all reasonable endeavours to meet any dates specified in the Confirmation, but any such dates are not guaranteed and, whilst we will use all reasonable endeavours to notify you in advance if we are unable to ensure a vehicle is available for a test drive on the specified date and to agree a mutually convenient alternative date, you will have no rights or remedies against us if we fail to ensure a vehicle is so available.

If we are not satisfied you hold a full UK driving licence and are legally fit to drive the vehicle on the date booked for the test drive, we will be entitled to cancel the Order and require you to rearrange an alternative date for the test drive.

If you wish to make a change to a date you have booked for a test drive, please contact us as soon as possible to book an alternative date. We may not be able to guarantee that the vehicle will still be available.

#### Events outside our control

We will not be liable or responsible for any failure to perform, or delay in performance of, any of our obligations under the Contract that is caused by any act or event beyond our reasonable control (Event Outside Our Control).

If an Event Outside Our Control takes place that affects the performance of our obligations under the Contract, we will contact you as soon as possible to let you know and we will take steps to minimise the effect of the delay. We will arrange a new date for the test drive after the Event Outside Our Control is over. Provided we do this we will not be liable for delays caused by the event, but if the Event Outside Our Control has continued, or seems likely to continue, for more than 30 days, you may contact us to cancel the Order and receive a refund of any reservation or booking fee you have paid.

#### How you may use material on our site

We are the owner or the licensee of all intellectual property rights in our site, and in the material published on it. Those works are protected by copyright laws and treaties around the world. All such rights are reserved.

Only if you are a business user:

#### Deposit:

In order to secure and reserve vehicle, Customer must pay deposit The amount of deposit customer pays is non-refundable Unless the refund term agreed Prior In writing by email ONLY ( [info@besureautos.co.uk](mailto:info@besureautos.co.uk) ). Your deposit will allow us to hold the vehicle for up to 7 days unless agreed prior in writing by email only if customer fail to perform And acted unreasonable then The deposit nonrefundable, we will re-list the vehicle.

#### Extended Warranty – 18 Months

We purchase and include an 18-month extended warranty from a third-party provider with the sale of all our vehicles. However, it is essential that customers comply fully with our terms and conditions. Any customers found to be misleading, uncooperative, or making false claims will be subject to discretionary review. Should we conclude that any breach has occurred, we reserve the right to retract the extended warranty, resulting in your vehicle no longer being covered by the warranty company.

#### Dealership Warranty

For any issues occurring within the first three months, customers must raise concerns directly with us by first steps to take video clip showing the vehicle registration, mileage and illuminated lights on the dashboard or any issues with the vehicle this evidence must be provided to our dealership via email at [info@besureautos.co.uk](mailto:info@besureautos.co.uk). This notification must be accompanied by a diagnostic report from authorised workshop, providing a statement of truth outlining the issue as ongoing prior to the sale. customer must never drive the vehicle while an issue identified all illuminated light displayed as this will cause further damage to the vehicle the customer will be held purely responsible. We will then investigate and provide further guidance. Failure to notify us promptly will result in rejection of any warranty claims.

#### Modification of Vehicle

Please note that any modifications made to the vehicle will immediately invalidate both the dealership and extended warranties.

#### Collection of Vehicle

Customers are responsible for thoroughly checking the vehicle, its condition, damages, and specifications against the advertisement at the time of collection. By collecting the vehicle, the customer agrees to accept it in the condition presented. Any discrepancies or issues must



be raised on the spot before collection for proper resolution. Claims made thereafter will be invalid unless supported by compelling evidence proving the issue existed prior to receipt.

#### Delivery of Vehicle

Similarly, for deliveries, customers must inspect the vehicle thoroughly against the advertisement before the driver departs. Any issues must be reported before the driver leaves the scene. If no issues are raised at this point, it will be assumed that the customer accepts the vehicle's condition. Subsequent claims will only be considered if supported by substantial proof that the problem existed before delivery.

Complaints: If a problem arises or you are dissatisfied with the Services, we have a comprehensive complaints policy (available from Besure Autos).

#### Cancellation (Non-Statutory)

In the event that the customer requests cancellation of the transaction other than pursuant to a statutory right of rejection, the customer shall be advised that the following charges will apply:

- A delivery and/or vehicle collection fee;
- An administrative fee;
- A usage charge calculated on a per-mile basis for mileage accrued during the customer's possession of the vehicle.

Upon return, the vehicle will be subject to a **full inspection**. Any damage, deterioration, faults, or remedial work identified that were not present at the point of sale will be rectified at the customer's cost. The full cost of such rectification, together with the charges outlined above, shall be **deducted from the original sales price** prior to any refund being issued.

#### General provisions

Assignment and transfer: We may assign or transfer our rights and obligations under the Contract to another entity but will always notify you in writing or by posting on this webpage if this happens. You may only assign or transfer your rights or your obligations under the Contract to another person if we agree in writing.

Waiver: If we do not insist that you perform any of your obligations under the Contract, or if we do not enforce our rights against you, or if we delay in doing so, that will not mean that we have waived our rights against you or that you do not have to comply with those obligations. If we do waive any rights, we will only do so in writing, and that will not mean that we will automatically waive any right related to any later default by you.

Severance: Each paragraph of these Terms operates separately. If any court or relevant authority decides that any of them is unlawful or unenforceable, the remaining paragraphs will remain in full force and effect.

Third party rights: The Contract is between you and us. No other person has any rights to enforce any of its terms.

Alternative dispute resolution: Alternative dispute resolution is a process where an independent body considers the facts of a dispute and seeks to resolve it, without you having to go to court. If you are a consumer and are not happy with how we have handled any complaint, you may want to contact the alternative dispute resolution provider we use. You can submit a complaint to Trading Standards. You can find your local branch via their website. In addition, please note that disputes may be submitted for online resolution to the European Commission Online Dispute Resolution platform.

Which country's laws apply to any disputes?

If you are a consumer, please note that these terms of use, their subject matter and their formation, are governed by English law. You and we both agree that the courts of England and Wales will have exclusive jurisdiction except that, if you are a resident of Northern Ireland you may also bring proceedings in Northern Ireland and, if you are resident of Scotland, you may also bring proceedings in Scotland.

If you are a business, these terms of use, their subject matter and their formation (and any non-contractual disputes or claims) are governed by English law. We both agree to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
